Report on visit to Milk Dairy and
Regional Museum of Natural History Mysore

The production of milk on dairy farms and the processing of milk and milk products at dairy plants makeup the dairy industry. To understand the working of a dairy industry and the quality assurance and to get the practical knowledge about them, we were taken to Mysore mega dairy at Alanahalli, Mysore on 28th of March 2023.

We reached the dairy at 10:30am and we entered the dairy at 11:00 am. We were accompanied by Smt. Sunitha. She guided us through various departments and sections of dairy unit.

Everyday milk is collected in tankers from 7 taluks and brought to the milk dairy. Then the sample is subjected to various tests like fat check, adulteration check, and acidity test. If the milk sample test is failed in quality assurance test it is rejected. Further good quality milk is taken for other process. First cream is separated then it is taken for butter conversion, later to the ghee preparation and packing.

Then we saw the section where 5 varieties of milk and 2 varieties of butter and curd are packed. Then we were taken to sweet section where peda and special Mysore pak is prepared. And we saw the preparation of paneer.

We were accompanied by Srinivas sir. Museum has multiple sections. The first section was related to biodiversity of southern region of India. The museum exhibits plants, animals, insects, butterflies and geology of the southern region of India. The galleries emphasize the conservation of nature and natural resources also he explained about ecological interrelationship among plants animals. There is a walk-through tunnel depicting evolution of life.

At 3:30 pm we were allowed to watch a short movie on wildlife titled as "Daraji". At the end of the day some colorful and informative scripts about plants, mammals, butterflies, reptiles, birds, seeds etc are provided from the museum.

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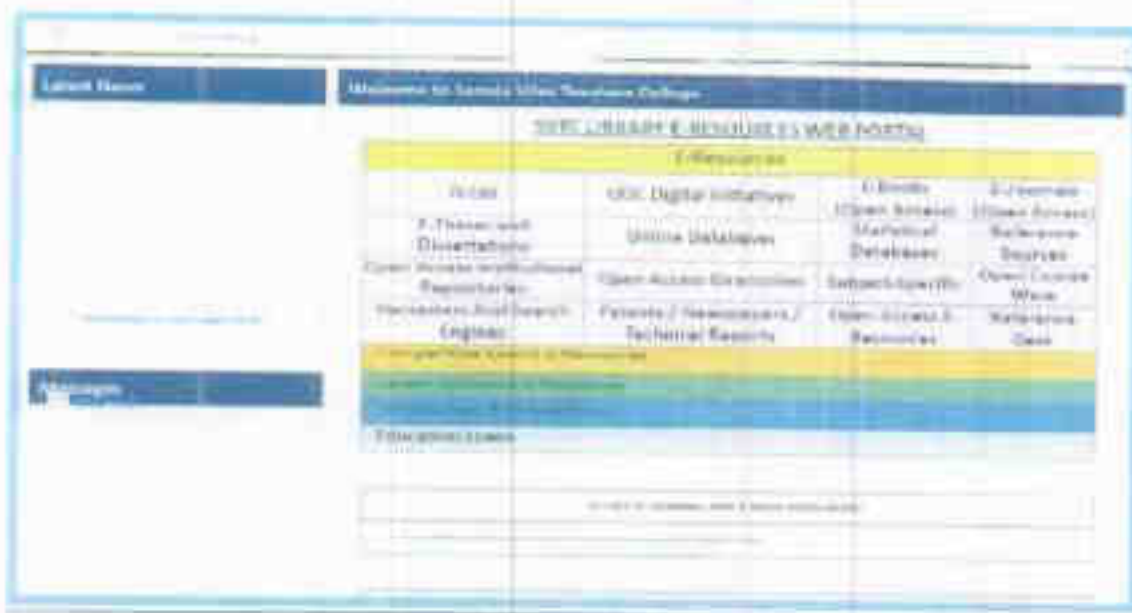

→ Definition

A unit test is one of the important evaluation tool. It is constructed, administered and evaluated by the teaching a particular unit to a group of students for whom he taught.

Unit test is a type of achievement test meant for particular unit of teaching by the classroom teacher.

→ Steps of Unit test

The perfect and valid unit test must have the following steps:

1. Planning the design of the test
2. Editing the unit test
3. Reviewing the test items
4. Administering the test
5. Interpreting the test result

→ Planning the design of the test

Planning of an activity is important to the achievement of the test results. So it is also very important to plan the design of the test.

devala test
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(i) Unit Analysis:

It is based on the scope and significance the unit must organize into convenient number of sub units.

(ii) Content Analysis:

It can be done for each sub unit by identifying and analyzing important facts, principles and concepts.

(iii) Weightage to Objective:

On the basis of NCERT norms, the suitable weightage should be given to all important objectives of teaching physics.

(iv) Weightage to the content:

Depending on the scope of the lesson, proper weightage should be given to all sub units and no-units left in the weightage.

(v) Weightage to the question:

Proper weightage should be given to all type of questions like objective type, short answer type and essay type.

(vi) Blue print:

The blue print is three dimensional chart showing the weightage given to the content type of questions and objectives in terms of marks. It is also called "table of specification" as it relates outcome to the content and indicates relative weightage of sub unit.

2] Editing the unit test:

(i) Construction of item:

The teacher should construct all possible number of

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questions on the unit under different objectives. The item must be of objective type, very short answer type, short answer type and essay type.

(i) Selection of test item:

Based on the blue print, the teacher has to select required number of test items.

(ii) Instruction of test item:

For each type of question, instruction must be written clearly, i.e., what to do, how much answer to be written.

(iii) Preparing, marking and scoring key:

The teacher should predetermined the scheme of evaluation and scoring key, expected answer and marks are allotted.

(iv) Question paper:

Question paper should print legibly in different section like part A, B, C, D etc.

(v) Revising the test item:

Critical evaluation of question paper must be made to ensure the correctness and grammatically constructed to overcome later confusion.

(vi) Interpreting the test result:

The test result has to be interpreted by statistical analysis based on central tendency, quartiles, npq and difficulty level.

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$$D = \frac{\text{Correct response}}{\text{Total number of students}}$$

→ Importance of Unit Test:

- * It helps in knowing the pupil's achievement.
- * It helps to know whether the objectives are achieved or not.
- * It is part of continuous evaluation.
- * It shows the gaps or leaving out areas of learning or teaching.
- * It is the best self-evaluation for teachers and pupil.
- * It helps to develop self-confidence in facing the examination.
- * It helps in the development of instructional programme and strategies.
- * It helps to have question related to all behavioural domains.

→ Characteristics of Unit Test:

- * Based on only one unit.
- * Conducted in fixed period of time.
- * Has fixed marks.
- * Carried on only after teaching the unit.
- * Based on blue print.
- * Conducted or prepared by the classroom teacher.
- * Achievement test.
- * Only for specific group/class students.
- * Part of CCE.
- * Remedial or enrichment aspect.

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* Meet the validity, objectivity, reliability of the unit test.

→ Objectives of unit test:

- * To know whether all of objectives are achieved or not.
- * To know learning level of students.
- * To improve the teaching methods and techniques.
- * To motivate the students towards learning.
- * To inspire the students in learning process.
- * To know the weakness and strength of the students.
- * To give feedback to both teachers and students.
- * To guide to set good question paper in future.

→ Criteria or conditions of Unit Test:

- * Select only taught unit.
- * Compulsorily based on unit and content analysis.
- * Selection of different types of questions.
- * Proper weightage to the objectives.
- * Writing up of test analysis.
- * Allowing marks and time for each item.
- * Proper instruction to each type of item.
- * Maintain difficulty level of the test item.
- * Based on blue print.
- * Print the question paper legibly without grammatical mistakes.
- * Test should be only for teaching groups.

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→ Advantages of Unit Test

- * The effectiveness of the teachers and responses of learners can be known.
- * The learning abilities and weakness of the students can be identified.
- * The continuous evaluation of learners can be made.
- * The achievement of objectives in the unit test will be known.
- * On the basis of scores obtained in the unit test, the students will be classified.
- * Teachers can understand their deficiencies of interesting and try to avoid them in future.
- * Unit test help to the teachers to take up remedial teaching.
- * It helps the teacher to give individual attention to the needy.
- * The teachers can guide the students in their learning activities.
- * By the unit tests students can have some experiences in facing the terminal and annual examination.

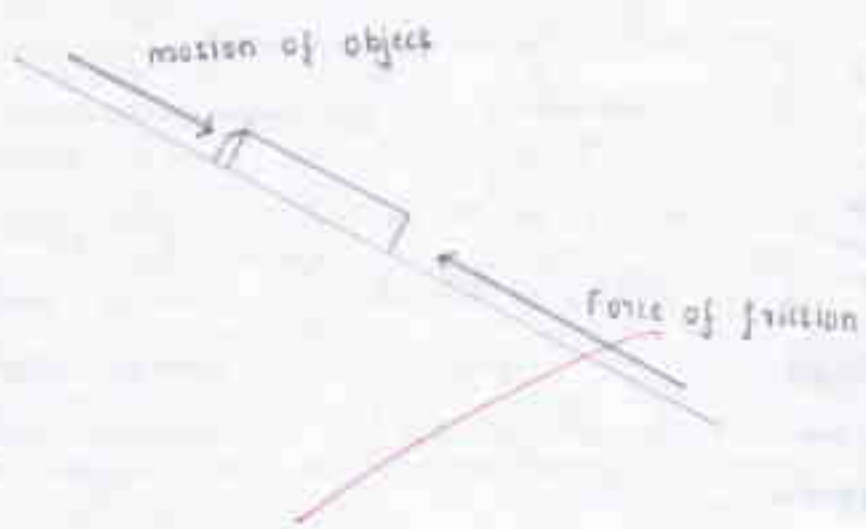

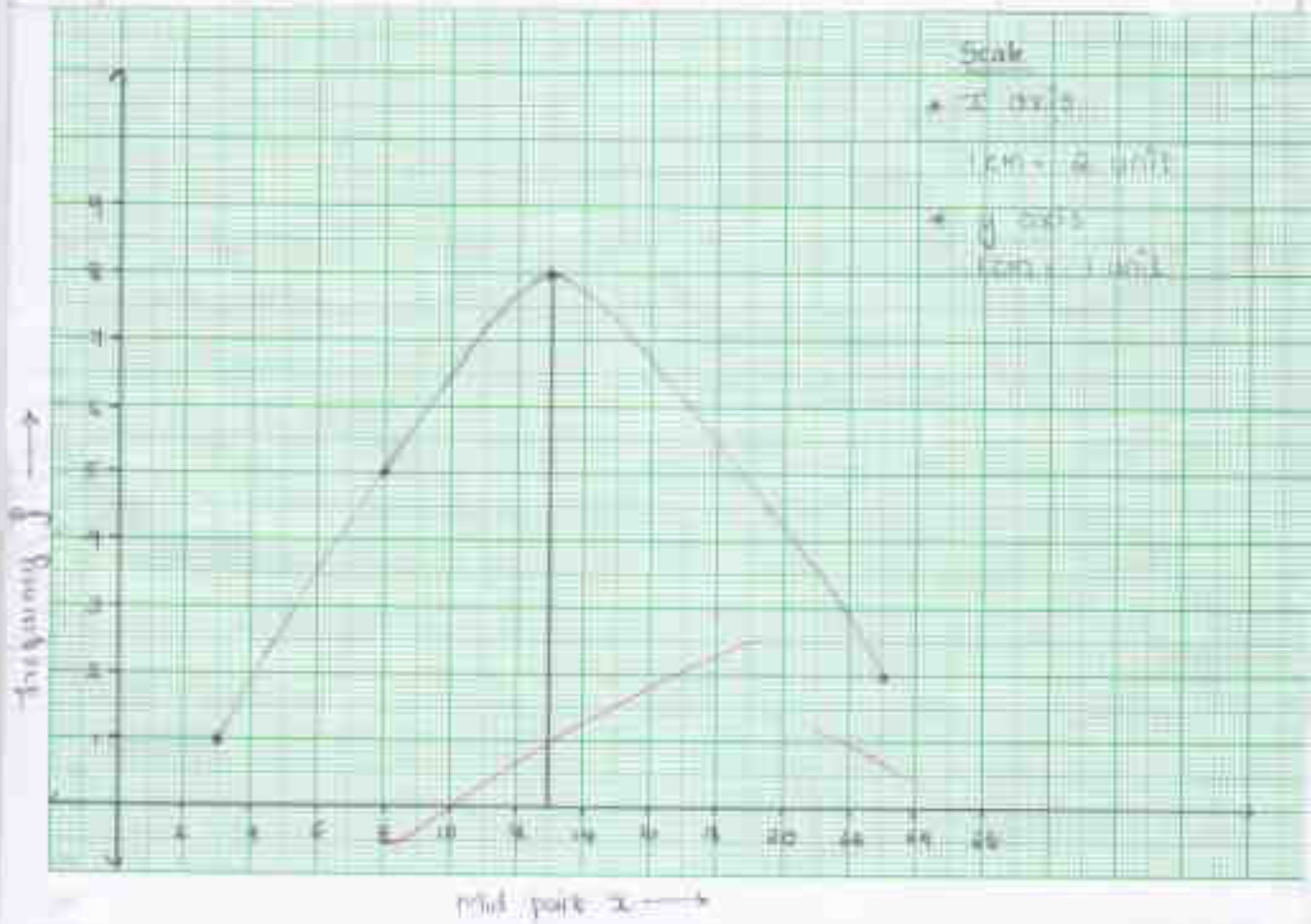

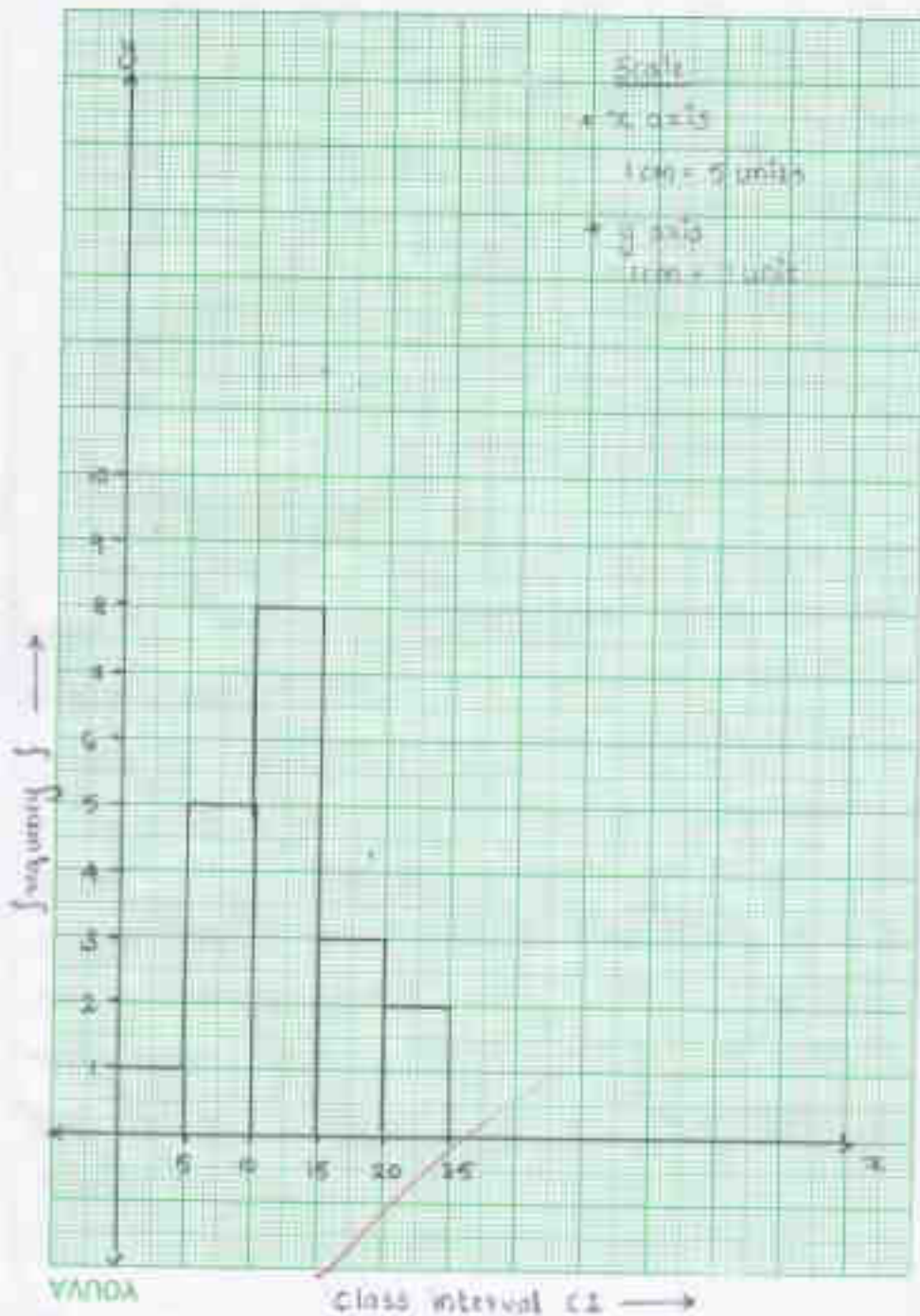
